Cape Lodge

Margaret River, Western Australia

3 nights

Cape Lodge private estate and boutique hotel in the heart of the **Margaret River** wine region. sits within 40 acres of manicured parkland and ornamental lakes and has its own 8 acre vineyard producing fine Sauvignon Blanc and Shiraz exclusively for guests of the hotel. This premium wine region has a strong reputation for fine gastronomic flavours and spectacular scenery, where rolling vineyards sit against a backdrop of ocean and forest.

What will I do there?

- Join a Cape Lodge cooking class designed for culinary enthusiasts. Keep an eye out for the Long Table Lunch calendar including the Truffle Hunt Tour.
- Gourmet Weekends are also scheduled throughout the year bringing together winemakers, food producers and lovers of food and wine with master classes, tastings and winemaker degustations.
- Spend time visiting a multitude of award winning, family owned wineries. Cape Lodge neighbours include the great wineries of Vasse Felix, Moss Wood, Pierro and Cullen.

The Louise

Barossa Valley, South Australia

3 nights

The Louise, an idyllic luxury vineyard retreat, encompassing acclaimed restaurant Appellation, is situated on a gentle hill surrounded by hundreds of acres of vines, with breathtaking vistas across the world renowned **Barossa Valley**.

What will I do there?

- Appellation features a nightly wine-paired Chef's Tasting Menu and believes that the sum of 'food + wine' should be greater than the individual parts and that wine is a finished product. A series of dishes created to pair with specific wines, creating a unique marriage, with ingredients directed by the season.
- On a Saturday morning, take to the Barossa Farmer's Market and share in the locals delight for the food of the region.
- Take an exclusive private tour of Seppeltsfield – a national treasure and living museum of Australian wine history.



1hr drive to Adelaide Airport, 1hr flight to Melbourne Airport, 90min drive to Lake House or arrange to arrive via scenic flight.

Lake House

Daylesford, Victoria

3 nights

An icon in regional dining, **Lake House** in **Daylesford** has long been considered to be one of Australia's best restaurants, championing local seasonal cuisine long before it became a mantra for many. The hotel and all manner of indulgent facilities that have grown around the restaurant over the past three decades continue to delight visitors from near and far. Indeed, Executive Director and Co-Proprietor Alla Wolf-Tasker AM has enough national and international awards to fill virtually every wall of her fabled house on the lake.

What will I do there?

- Dine at the multi-award winning Lake House Restaurant.
- Farm Gate & Winery Tour – head out for the day with a local guide and meet the farmers, producers and winemakers who passionately connect the 'paddock to plate'. There's organic and biodynamic producers, rare breed farmers, producers of goat and sheep's milk cheese, cider, beer & winemakers, bakers and more.
- Meander through the property grounds and explore the Kitchen Garden planted out with herbs and edible flowers. Orchard areas include olives, crabapple, stone fruits, apple, quince and medlar.



Optional - As an extension to this culinary experience, also consider a taste of Queensland, visiting Spicers Peak Lodge.

What will I do there?

Learn about the typical unifying characteristics, the fermentation, distillation and ageing processes.
