Kingston Heath Golf Club, Melbourne

A jewel of the Melbourne Sandbelt, <u>Kingston Heath</u> enjoys an enviable reputation for its superb conditioning all year round.

The course harnesses the natural dips and hollows of the landscape to create surprising challenges to the non-observant golfer.
